## **Enterprise Community Partners and Local Initiatives Support Corporation – Power Forward Communities**

Power Forward Communities is a coalition of trusted national organizations — United Way Worldwide, Habitat for Humanity International, Enterprise Community Partners, Local Initiatives Support Corporation (LISC), and Rewiring America — that have collectively spent decades building stronger, healthier, affordable communities and homes, with a focus on low-income families. They have come together to combine national reach and complementary strengths to deploy funds from the National Clean Investment Fund, part of the Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund and the Inflation Reduction Act. So far, they've brought together a coalition of 321 partners, including 156 local communities across 46 states in every EPA region, to support the goal of decarbonizing homes and driving a market transformation that cuts costs and benefits communities across the nation.
