

Who are our clients?

- Individuals with income below the Federal Poverty level
- Veterans
- The disabled (SSI or SSDI recipients)
- The Homeless
- The Elderly
- The Mentally III
- A large percentage of Minorities







- Flaking/ peeling paint
- Open and vacant structures
- Dumping/ trash removal
- Other conditions on the property that appear to be unsafe for occupants or the general public.

What are the most common Housing Code violations?

- Damaged soffit boards
- Decayed/ damaged roofs
- Broken window glass
- Overgrown grass
- Broken doors
- Damaged walls
- Littered vacant lots

What is the penalty for a Housing Code violation?

- Penalties vary, but according to the law, a person can be fined up to \$1,000; and
- Sentenced up to 6 months in jail for a city ordinance

What are the challenges of a Housing Code violation?

The biggest challenges are financial.

Many times, the client cannot afford the necessary repairs, or needs assistance bringing the property into compliance.



If a person is cited for a Housing Code violation, are they entitled to an attorney?



Yes! If you cited for a housing code violation in the City of Atlanta, you have a right to an attorney. You can either hire an attorney or request a Public Defender.

How does the Public Defender help?

- We take a social approach to handling cases
- Many people just want to be heard, we listen
- We go to the properties and help connect clients with resources
- We look for the source of their circumstance
- We aid in social services to prevent recidivism

- We negotiate with the solicitor's office and code enforcement
- We defend citizens in the courtroom
- We help with probate issues and ownership issues that may be preventing people from doing anything with the property
- We aid in appeals

How can the community help?

- Educating community members and neighbors
- Listening to the residents' needs
- Connecting residents to social services
 - a. Ex. Office of the Public Defender
- Volunteering to make the repairs
 - a. Prior to contacting code enforcement or giving a citation
- Giving residents time to cure alleged violations
 - a. Prior to contacting code enforcement or giving a citation

A home inspection is an examination and observation of a residential property that focuses on the Big 5:

- ? HVAC
- ? PLUMBING
- ? ELECTRICAL
- ? ROOF
- **? FOUNDATION**
- Visual Observation
- -(Accessible) and Non-invasive





A Home Inspector is NOT:

- Real Estate Agent
- Appraiser
- Loan Officer
- Land Surveyor









- YOU ARE INFORMED:
 You can make an educated decision
- IT'S INEXPENSIVE: Hundreds of dollars vs Thousands of dollars in repairs
- REASSURING
 You know the home was thoroughly inspected



WE ARE NOT HERE TO:

- Promote fear
- To make a judgment for you
- To inspect cosmetic flaws
- Make repairs
- Give estimates for repairs






Average Home Inspection Ranges between \$400-\$450

Price determining factors:

- Size of the property
- Age of the property
- Location of the home
- Additional tests





Home inspections are generally performed when a home is either being purchased or sold.

Seller

Correct defects that could hinder the sale

Buyer

Knowledge of defective items prior to closing





Should I Get a Home Inspection if the Home is Being Sold "AS IS"?































- RADON(Lung Cancer)


